

A group of Adults meet at 9:00am each Sunday to study God's word. Pastor Jane Piehl leads these sessions.


On February 24th the group will start the study by Ray Vander Laan titled "God Heard Their Cry" which focuses on how we can find "freedom in the midst of life's trials".

New Member's Class


Thinking of joining Sharon Center UMC in a more formal way? Join us for a gathering of persons who would like to know more about the United

Weather Emergencies Update Relating to Sharon Center UMC

At the recent Admin Board meeting, there was discussion regarding some of the weather emergencies that Medina County has experienced this year, such as the sudden severe snowstorm, and recent high wind emergency. As a safety measure, should snow or other extreme weather conditions occur in Medina County that generate an <u>official</u> <u>Level 2 or above</u> emergency situation, all meetings, activities, and Worship services on that day or evening will be cancelled at Sharon Center UMC for the safety of all concerned. Should an official Level 1 snow or weather emergency situation be in effect, the church will remain open for Worship services, activities, and meetings, and the decision to hold activities or attend them will be made by those involved in the activities or meetings.

If you are wondering how to tell if there is a Level 2 or Level 1 weather emergency, the Medina County Sheriff's Office places weather alerts on their Facebook page. Several local TV and radio stations post severe weather alerts, and a free service is offered by Medina County Emergency Management Agency (phone: 330-722-9240). Residents can sign up by phone or online for their weather notification service. Then in the event of a local emergency, an alert will be sent by phone call, text message, and / or e-mail. An optional weather warning service will alert subscribers when a weather warning is issued by the National Weather Service.
