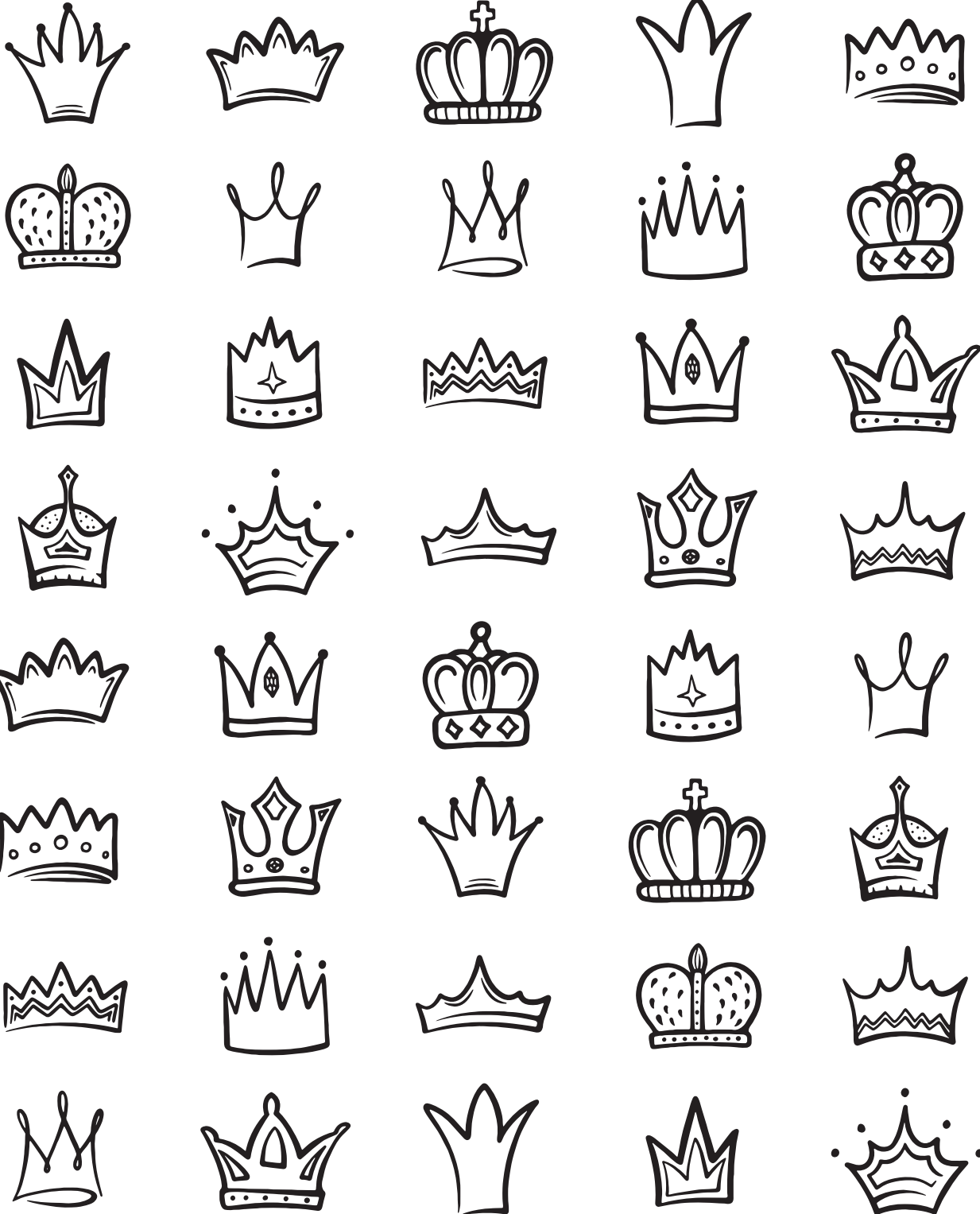
Queen Esther asked the king for help. Color Queen Esther. Then, color the king.

Have a Banquet – Puzzle

Esther hosted a banquet for the king. Work together to host your own banquet!
Divide into four teams. Each team should complete one of the cards on 7D and 7E.

TEAM 1

Your job is to create a place setting for each person in your class. Choose a place for each person in your class to sit. Don't forget to include your teachers! Use index cards to make a name card for each person's spot at the table.

Each place setting should have:

- a plate and napkin
- a fork, spoon, and knife
- a cup
- a name card

TEAM 2

Your job is to put all the food out so that members of your class can help themselves to a delicious meal. You may choose to use a table in the classroom or ask your teacher about the best way to make the food available.

Don't forget to:

- Wear nitrile gloves while handling the food.
- Place serving spoons and other utensils near the food.
- Instruct members of your class how they should serve themselves.

TEAM 3

Your job is to clean up the table where the members of your class ate the meal. Make sure to ask if the members of your class have finished before disposing of their plates, cups, and other items.

Be sure to:

- Throw away items like plates, napkins, and utensils.
- Wipe down the table or tablecloth with a sponge or cloth.
- Help get the classroom put back together.

TEAM 4

Your job is to clean up the serving area. Ask your teacher or teachers what should be thrown away and what should be put into storage containers or baggies.

Remember to:

- Throw away all the items that should be discarded.
- Wash serving spoons or other utensils.
- Wipe down surfaces with a sponge or cloth.
