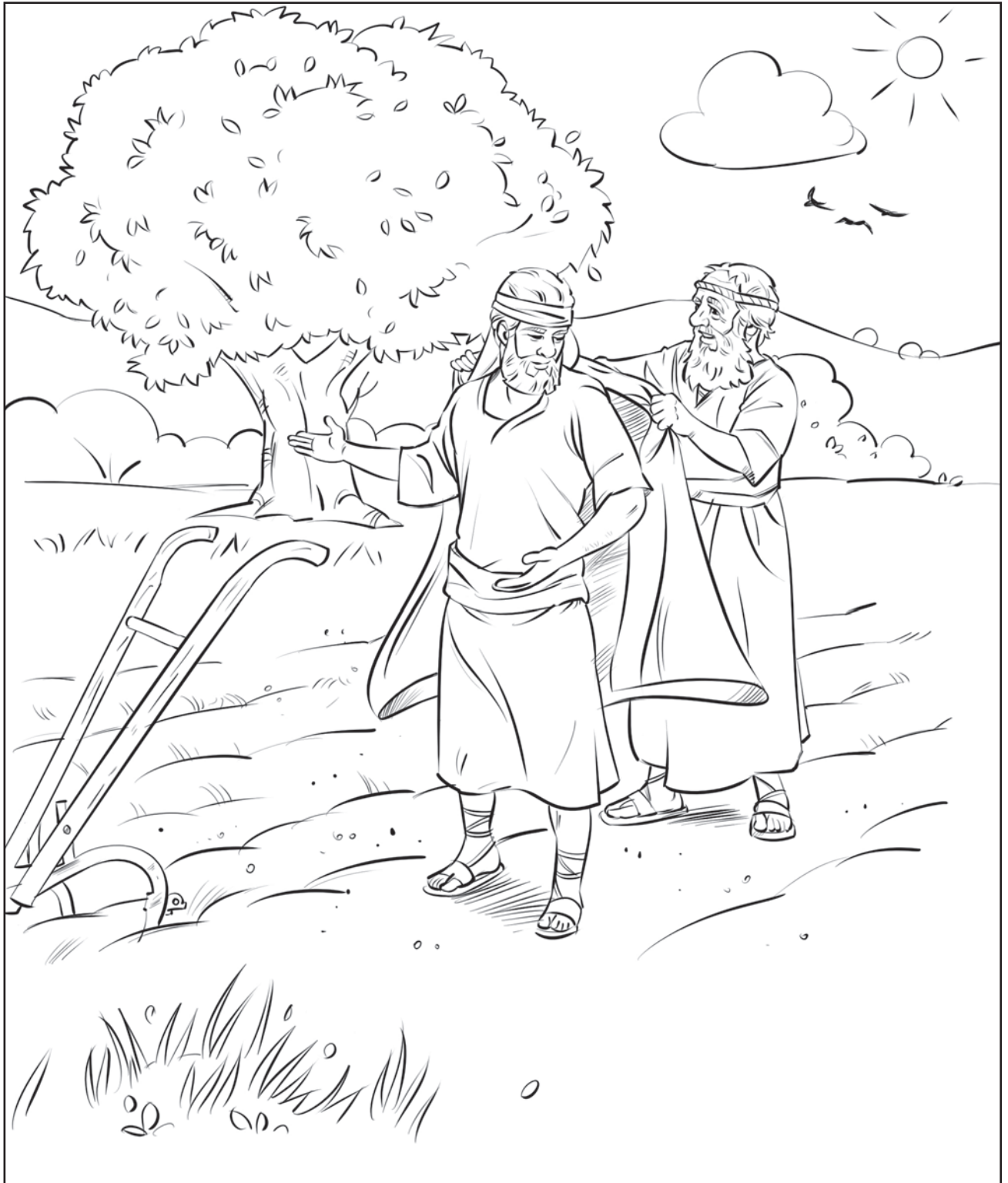

What Do Names Mean? – Activity

Names mean something. That is especially true for names in the Bible. Use this sheet to learn what the meaning of the names Elijah and Elisha.



ELIJAH - Elijah means "My God is Yahweh." The first part "El" is a word that means God.

The letters "jah" are pronounced "yah." Yahweh is a name for God in the Old Testament.



ELISHA - Elisha means "God is salvation." The first part, "El" is a word that means God.

The Hebrew word "elishua" means "God is salvation." So the name Elisha is a slightly shortened version of that word.
