Happy New Year! We greet our friends and those we meet this time of year with a friendly wish for a better future, a better tomorrow, a better year than the one we just finished. Whether or not we are ready, time rushes by and things change. My Mom used to say, "The only thing that I know for sure is that things will change." And they do. We can accept, or we can be miserable.

We were surprised in March of 2020 to learn of this strange new virus called "COVID19" and faced months and months of being separated. And then just when we thought we might get back to some kind of normal, new mutations of the virus emerged and we are currently in a new wave of illness. I'm sure it will all change again, and we have to be resilient, able to adapt to the changing environment, and leave it in God's hands.

We renewed our covenant – our promise to God to be his people – during the Wesleyan Covenant Service on January 2. We vowed to commit our whole selves to following Jesus: with our prayers, our presence, our gifts, our service, our witness, our bodies and our lives. Romans 12:11-2 is one of my favorite verses about giving ourselves to God: "Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship. Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will." The way we offer ourselves to God changes over time, just as we change over time. My skills grow and change. What I did yesterday may not work today. My body gets stronger and weaker and the way I offer to serve changes over time. The thing that doesn't change is that God accepts my offering as a pleasing sacrifice when I offer it with my whole heart. That's good news.

What are you offering God today? Is it your best? Being intentional about our gifts to God makes them more real and meaningful. Giving him our best is an act of Worship. Colossians 3:23 says, "Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters".

Lent begins with an Ash Wednesday Service at 7:00 PM on March 2. In the meanwhile, we look for the presence of God in the ordinary of our lives, in the face of our loved ones or the ice on our windowsill. Every season has it's purpose under heaven.


