Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As I write this, the sun is shining and it's forecast to be almost fifty degrees outside today. I can see grass poking up between the mounds of snow along the road and down my driveway. As people who live in Ohio, we have accepted the change of season and are used to the changes – sometimes all in the same day. We are prepared for whatever comes our way with shovels, salt, umbrella, sunglasses and sunscreen. But are we prepared for a change in spiritual seasons?

I remember being surprised as a young person realizing that not every Church celebrated Lent, the 40 days (not counting Sundays) leading up to Resurrection Day. I've always enjoyed the idea of preparing my soul and my physical space for Holy Week, spending time with God and taking inventory of my faith and my life. Matthew 24:44 say, "So you also must be ready, because the Son of Man will come at an hour when you do not expect him." Being ready implies preparation, awareness, alertness and faith. Lent gives me all these things.

We'll begin on Wednesday, March 2 with a gathering of God's people for a simple meal of soup and bread at 6PM in Fellowship Hall, followed by a service of repentance and the imposition of ashes at 7PM.

During this season of forty days, we'll be placing ourselves in the story of the passion of Jesus, exploring what it may have been like to be in the story. In each instance we'll talk about the risk involved. As a follower of Jesus, what are you risking? Or do you like to play it safe? Those that followed Jesus risked their reputation, dignity, failure, rejection, loss of friends/family and temptation. Key moments for our Lent journey include entry into Jerusalem, cleansing the temple, teaching about money, anointing with alabaster oil, last supper, the garden prayer at Gethsemane. Where are you in the story? Are you standing at the edge of the crowd– or are you part of the action?

I invite you to participate in the Celebration of Life services our faithful saints who have passed into eternity. We will have a Memorial Service for Guy and Wanda Quick on Sunday, March 13 at 1PM and for Elaine Mravetz on Saturday, March 19 at 11AM. The community of faith is encouraged to come and participate as we remember the wonderful life-giving Words of everlasting life that are made possible through the sacrifice and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. May every day be a witness to the resurrection and a celebration of the life we are given.


# Did Someone Hand You This Newsletter?

"The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit" Psalm 34:18


Thursdays 7:00 PM from April 21 -May 26, 2022 Sharon Center United Methodist Church

Maple Syrup Day in Wooster for Sparks & Friends March 12 from 3 to 5 PM - Please join us!

From the Director: The Christian Children's Home of Ohio (Advance Special 9977) is blessed to have over 700 Maple Trees on our property at 2685 Armstrong Road, Wooster, Ohio. An arborist inspected our woods, and we can tap the trees and make some outstanding Maple Syrup.

Our children are collecting the sap, but we need help. A Northeast Ohio grocery store chain is putting the CCHO Maple Syrup on its shelves and promoting it. All the proceeds benefit our children. Plus, the kids experience the joy of making Maple Syrup!

When you arrive, go to our maintenance building which is in the northwest corner of our property. There is a parking lot there. Call our Facility Director Jeff Stump when you arrive. Jeff's mobile phone number is 330.466.2117. Jeff or a member of his team will show you what to do and give you everything you need.

You'll be directed to the woods where the Maple Trees are. The tapped trees have 3-gallon plastic bags attached to them with a spile (spigot). You will drain the bags into five-gallon buckets. To do this, you simply tip the bag sideways and the sap pours out of a hole that's been cut in the corner of the bag. The bag never comes off the tree.

When a bucket is filled you carry it to our Gator vehicle and place it into the storage bed. The bed holds up to 8, 5-gallon buckets. When the buckets are filled, you drive them to a 275-gallon plastic vat at the entrance of the woods and dump the contents into the vat. However many you are able to empty during your time period is fine. Take breaks if you get tired. Enjoy the scenery.
