Dear Friends and Fellow Disciples of Jesus Christ,

Recently I heard the sounds of the Spring peepers rising from the nearby ponds and woods and I was comforted, knowing that God was in control and He has my best interests in mind. I sit at my desk and hear the crows noisily cawing outside and I am reminded that God cares for the birds of the air, even the obnoxious ones. I hear the rain tapping on the window and the wind blowing through the trees and I know that my God will supply everything I need.

Change will come, that's a fact. My Mother used to say that the only thing that is constant is change. My comfort comes in knowing that God has a plan, and that while things change, God remains the same. So I listen for my Father's voice, for the signs that He is with me, for the sounds of encouragement and hope. I will continue to seek Him.

Proverbs 8:17 says, "I love those who love me, and those who seek me diligently find me."



Book Club


We meet at 10:00am in the Conference Room at the Church. Please join us at any time to discuss the books.




Summer Camp

I was, and continue to be the tortoise, accepting the fact that progress would proceed very slowly, but steadily.


Please remember that everyone of you have been a part in helping me deal with both the mental and physical struggles. I am truly blessed to have so much support.
