#### Dear Friends,

Every year I read through the Bible chronologically – I read it in the order the events happened in the Bible and not the way it's printed. It helps me to understand how the Bible is history. I also can see where it repeats, and where different people describe the same event from alternative viewpoints.

There are other ways to read the Bible: some read a chapter a day, or through a whole book at once. Some read only a few verses, but then meditate on them throughout the day. There is no "wrong" way to read the Bible. The only "wrong" way to read the Bible is not to read it at all.

"All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work" (2 Timothy 3:16-17).

Each Sunday, Millie or I present a children's message because it's important to start early to get kids interested in God's Word. We offer Sunday School so that kids can get a taste of the major stories of the Bible that hopefully are reinforced at home. Confirmation Class is offered every couple of years to youth from seventh grade on up. Bible Studies are on-going on Tuesday evenings. It is my hope that the message is coming through: you need to be in the Word.

If this church is going to grow in bringing people to Christ and in growing the numbers of people in our pews, we will need to be people of prayer and people of the Word: We will need to be true to Christ, to be kind to people, and to take the Gospel to the nations. Our hospitality will need to be on our faces and in our actions. We will need to be creative, mission minded and always looking out for the weak and vulnerable. I'm ready.
