All: O God, Searcher of all our hearts, you have formed us as a people and claimed us for your own. As we come to acknowledge your sovereignty and grace, and to enter anew into covenant with you, reveal any reluctance or falsehood within us. Let your Spirit impress your truth on our inmost being, and receive us in mercy, for the sake of our Mediator, Jesus Christ, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. Amen.

INVITATION

Leader: Commit yourselves to Christ as his servants. Give yourselves to him, that you may belong to him. Let us, therefore, go to Christ, and pray:

All: Let me be your servant, under your command. I will no longer be my own. I will give up myself to your will in all things.
