We will have choir rehearsal the following Thursdays: January 25 at 7pm, and sing on Jan. 28 February 22 at 7pm and sing on Feb. 25


Thank you to all who left Christmas cards and gifts on the piano or piano bench last month! I was constantly surprised by your kindness and generosity! Happy New Year!


